

Mega Star-in-a-Star Baby Quilt Tutorial

This quilt finishes at 40" square.

Fabric Requirements:

Lt Gray: 2 yds

Dk Gray: 1 yd

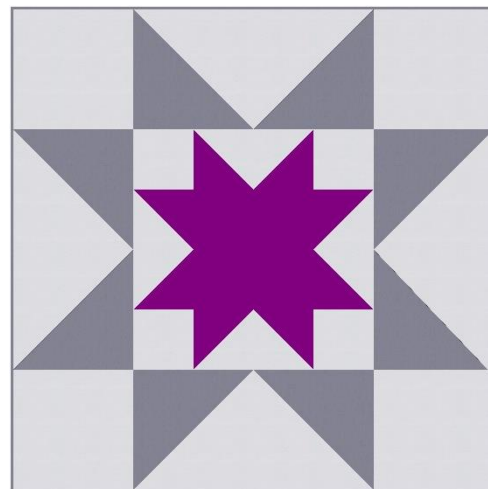
Magenta: ½ yd

Backing: 1 ¼ yds

Cutting Instructions:

Cut the following strips.

WOF = width of fabric.



Lt Gray

- Three strips @ 10 ½" x WOF
 - o Sub cut two strips in to 4 pieces 10 ½" x 20 ½"
 - o Sub cut the remaining strip in to 4 pieces 10 ½" x 10 ½"
- Two strips @ 5 ½" x WOF
 - o Sub cut one strip in to 4 pieces 5 ½" x 10 ½"
 - o Sub cut the remaining strip in to 4 pieces 5 ½" x 5 ½"

Dk Gray

- One strip @ 10 ½" x WOF
 - o Sub cut the strip in to 8 pieces 10 ½" x 10 ½"

Magenta

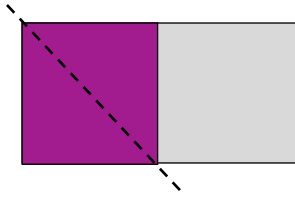
- One strip 10 ½" x WOF
 - o Sub cut strip in to one square 10 ½" x 10 ½"
 - o From the remaining strip, cut squares 5 ½" x 5 ½"
- One strip 5 ½" x WOF
 - o Sub cut strip in to 5 ½" squares until you have a total of 8 squares this size.

Assembling the Quilt

Star Points

You are going to add dk gray star points to the large lt gray rectangles using the dk gray squares.

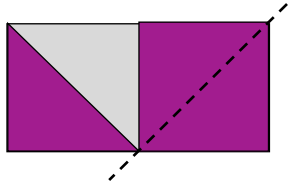
You are going to add magenta star points to the small lt gray rectangles using the smaller magenta squares.



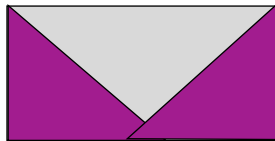
Place a magenta 5 1/2" square on a 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangle and sew diagonally from one corner to the other as shown in the diagram to the left. Repeat three more times.



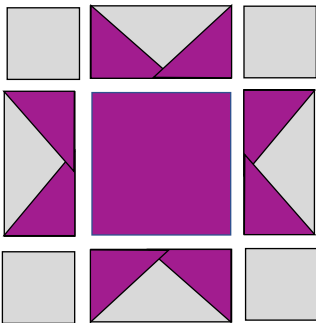
Trim 1/4" from your stitching line and discard the extra triangles of fabric. Press the magenta triangle down.



Place a second 5 1/2" magenta square on the other side of the lt gray rectangle, and again sew from one corner diagonally to the other, according to the diagram at left. Trim & press.



The resulting blocks will look like the diagram to the left. Repeat with the large lt gray rectangles and dk gray squares.



Assemble your inner saw tooth star block using the 5 1/2" lt gray squares and the large magenta 10 1/2" square. See diagram to the left for layout.

Using the large lt gray rectangle units and the large lt gray squares (10 1/2" x 10 1/2") assemble the quilt top according to the diagram at right.

Voila!
